

Global Parts Inc. has established an export compliance program and is respectfully requesting your assistance in our efforts to comply with U.S. export and re-export regulations as they may apply to you and your business.

As part of our due diligence; this notice is to provide you with a reminder of the potential opportunities for restricted activities and request that no resale, transfer or re-export of items purchased from Global Parts, Inc. be made by you to restricted entities or activities without U.S. Government authorization.

Export Control Reform is now a reality and places some military items previously controlled by the Department of State U.S. Munitions List (ITAR) under the Department of Commerce's U.S. Commerce Control List (EAR) which has significantly changed U.S. export and re-export controls.

Overall, U.S. and foreign parties must obtain prior written U.S. Government authorization to facilitate or participate in activities when parts purchased from Global Parts, Inc. could be exported or re-exported under the following restrictions:

- Parties on U.S. Government prohibited parties lists and denial lists
- Embargoed countries which to date are Cuba, Iran, North Korea, Sudan and Syria
- Sensitive nuclear activities, missiles/rockets/UAVs, or chemical or biological weapons
- Military activities in China
- Military related items still covered under the control of the U.S. Munitions List
- Commercial, dual-use and former military items controlled by the U.S. Commerce Control List
- Other "Red Flag" indicators that may be evident
